History

Delta Safety Society was founded in October, 1942 and is the oldest organization of its kind in the metropolitan New Orleans area; Since 1942 Delta has expanded to include members from throughout Southern Louisiana. Delta is a non-profit organization composed of enthusiastic health and safety professionals. Many past and present members have reached national recognition within the fields of safety, health and environmental.

Objective and Purpose

Delta's objective and purpose shall be to promote the arts and sciences of engineering in their relation to the preservation and protection of life, limb and property; to promote the civic and professional welfare of its members, to engage in recognized community safety council activities and to further any efforts toward community safety.

Membership
