With the exception of motor vehicle crashes, falls are the single biggest cause of occupational death and injury in the United States. According to the National Safety Council, hundreds of workers die each year from injuries caused by falls.

Falls pose a particularly severe hazard in the construction industry, accounting for the greatest number of deaths year after year. The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) reports that approximately one-third of all deaths are due to falls. OSHA has established a revised standard on fall protection, Subpart M, which covers the construction industry.
