



Safe Sitter® Class **Includes CPR**

The Metropolitan Safety Council offers a 7 or 14-hour Safe Sitter® class for ages 10+. Class will include both the Safe Sitter® Certificate and the Child & Infant CPR & AED Certificate (valid for 2 years). Taken together, the course is designed to give the students the knowledge and confidence to respond to an emergency situation with skills that could save a life.
