Alcohol, Drugs, and Driving Awareness Course (ADDAC) 7-Hour Course Outline

Educational programs comprise only one countermeasure in the post-detection portion of an impaired-driver control system. However, when considered as a single component in a system of countermeasures (that includes enforcement, adjudication, public information, and counseling) educational programs make a positive contribution to alcohol & drug traffic safety by reducing the recidivism of multiple offense or impaired drivers.

This course is accepted in Louisiana for adult driver educational programs and its components have been selected to reflect positive re-enforcement of today's alcohol & drug awareness efforts. All presenters are National Safety Council certified Defensive Driving Instructors. A Certificate of Completion is issued to each student who successfully completes the course.
